



RULES OF PROCEDURE ONLY RELATED TO
THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY PLENARY SESSION

1. Quorum:

The quorum is defined as the presence of $\frac{2}{3}$ of the member states.

2. Amendments:

No amendments shall be entertained during the General Assembly Plenary Session.

3. Draft resolution submission:

Draft resolutions must be submitted to the Chairing Panel, then to the Approval Panel after the General Assembly Plenary sessions' lobbying and merging session on the third day of the conference.

4. Resolution:

Regular process as regular committees, refer to the rules of procedures.

5. Voting Procedures:

Substantive Voting: Voting on matters of substance will require a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority¹ to pass.

Procedural Voting: same process as regular committees.

¹ Only members who have voted with a yes or no will be considered for the majority. Members which have abstained will not be considered.
