Topic: "Endorsing Green Economy in the context of achieving sustainable development goals"

The Ecosoc council,

Fully aware that chemical fertilizer may contain ingredients that may be toxic to the skin or respiratory system, and if we use it too much, it can kill plants, and it causing long-term imbalances in soil fertility,

Realizing that sustainable energy is sustainable so it will never run out, and sustainable energy facilities require less maintenance than tradition generators, and more importantly, sustainable energy has lowest impact on the environment,

Deeply regretting that 783 million people do not have access to clean water, 6 to 8 million people die annually from the consequences of disasters and water-related diseases,

Fully aware that deforestation and it can have serious effects, it destroys animal's homes, for example, many different types of animals in South America were lost before scientists could learn about them, and deforestation also affects the climate. The deforestation causes CO2 witch builds up and adds to the global warming,

Deeply convinced that the world should recycle because it will help the reducing of landfill, and reducing of energy consumption, and it decrease pollution, and the important reason of why the United States of America is now one of the world powerful countries, is that it recycles,

Affirming the need for foreign investments to endorse and enhance the chances for environmental sustainability,

Convinced that most of the world population does not realize the usage, effectiveness and reliability of green economy,

Noting with regret that fossil fuels are the major energy sources but still when over consumption takes place lead to disastrous effects such as air pollution. Burning of fossil fuels releases carbon dioxide, nitrogen monoxide, nitrogen dioxide, carbon monoxide etc. that have severe consequences on the environments. They also affect human health,

Acknowledging the undeveloped countries needs supports in a lot of resources in water, energy, and etc.

Deeply concerned that million of people die because of poverty, pollution, and lack of dirty water, so the world bank have to fund for the NGOS, and for the international green economical projects to solve those problems.

1. **Strongly** supports the evolution of agriculture by forbidding the use of chemical fertilizers and by encouraging the use of organic fertilizers.
2. **Encourages** the usage of sustainable energy by using renewable energy power generation and encouraging the use of emerging technologies such as:
 - a. Marine Energy: the energy carried by ocean waves, tides, salinity, and ocean temperature differences.
 - b. Encourages the United Nations to sponsor projects to use renewable energy power generation by using dams, and water energy with water wades
3. **Endorses** the access to clean water by forbidding the use of chemicals in sea, lake and river waters and punishing throwing factory waste into waters:
 - a. A special UN subsidiary body must be created to further overview this subject and specify the punishments.
4. **Adopts** the policy of helping maintain forests all around the world:
 - a. By implying economic sanctions on countries who endanger the forests present on their ground;
5. **Calls upon** countries and NGO's to help and further adopt the usage of recycling:
 - a. Encourages companies, governments and NGO's to take the lead in recycling projects;
 - b. Further encourages developed countries to help other countries who do not have the structure to setup such arrangements;
6. **Suggests** foreign investments to endorse and enhance the chances for environmental sustainability by:
 - a. Increased employments, which will enhance in power, efficient and speed of constructions;
 - b. Technological developments that will facilitate complicated project;
 - c. New markets that will internationalize the quality and variety of products;
 - d. Local economic spillovers; it will augment any countries' economy;
 - e. In that case, it will contribute in ending poverty;

7. **Encourages** Spreading awareness campaigns to enlighten many and if possible every citizen about the importance of sustainable development by;
 - a. Ensuring that it is a healthier more reliable economy;

8. **Appeals** the banning the usage of fossil fuels in the world to prevent sickness and death cause by pollution such as the one present in the air caused by factories that surround our homes.
 - a. Providing undeveloped and developing countries with green energy donated by powerful and developed countries.

9. **Encourages** developed countries such as the United States of America must contribute credible reductions.
 - a. Without threatening growth but instead, they could design mechanism and institutions to providing funds;
 - b. Share technologies with developing countries to enhance economic conditions in developed and undeveloped countries such as the Middle East;

10. **Invite** World Bank to fund international green economical projects such as;
 - a. BRAC (the Bangladesh Rural Advancement Committee);
 - b. The Wikimedia foundation;
 - c. Acumen funds;
