QUESTION OF: The Arab republic of Egypt's Infrastructure



MAIN SUBMITTER: Prime Minister

The Special Conference Forum,

Fully Alarmed that petrol and natural gas prices have risen about 65% and this has affected taxi drivers and therefore the transportation issues that we face today, all of this because of the import of less fuel than export to certain countries,

Taking into consideration that the Muslim Brotherhood have disrupted the streets and traffic in their last few protests against President Sisi which led to economic problems in Egypt,

Reaffirming, that traffic problems have been spotted everywhere and that almost 5 cars commit accidents and cause traffic jams every day,

Acknowledging that electric blackouts occur almost every 3 h in a certain area and these blackouts cause a lot of dysfunction to the Egyptian way of life,

Affirming that during the reign of President Morsi the Egyptian GDP has gone down about \$1500 million because of the reliance of the Egyptian government on the International Monetary Fund,

Aware that grocery prices have risen up about 55% which added more difficulty to the Egyptian citizen and his way of living,

Realizing that the water cuts that occur every now and then actually lessen the number of water products that get manufactured and therefore the export of water products and other related goods and that causes the decrease in money,

Keeping in mind that traffic jams are also caused by driving problems and corrupt driving training that most taxi drivers, bus and microbus drivers take,

Alarmed that now robberies occur more often because of lack of security during Former President Morsi's regime,

Knowing this actually shows that also harassments and the diffuse of angry mobs increase,

Concerned that drug cartels and arms dealing increase the danger in the streets because of corruption in the police department during former President Morsi's regime and his Excellency not taking care of it,

Knowing that the government is doing electricity blackouts because of the miss of electric factories in Egypt,

Bearing in mind that a big part of the Egyptian population has slow internet (air mobile connection), or even no internet connection,

Acknowledging that Egypt has some problems of gas because of the gas smuggling to Palestine,

Affirming the problems in transportation such as jam in the bus or other,

Deeply conscious that the Egyptian citizens use electricity and water too much,

Accepting the fact that the transportation in Egypt is of the upmost corruption and needs to be delft with,

Knowing that illegal parking is causing a lot of concern in traffic and therefore causing traffic jams,

1. Requests the immediate cut of petrol and natural gas between the Arab republic of Egypt and the state of Israel;
2. Calls upon the import of less petrol to most countries and exporting more petrol so the gas problem settles until further and more serious issues settle,
3. Recommends the immediate arrest of MB demonstrators who disrupted the traffic conditions;
4. Demands building more windmills producing electricity in the Mediterranean area because of more wind trajectories in this area;
5. Alarming the IMF of the situation in Egypt and there immediate action to fix economic aspects in Egypt;

6. Deducts the judging of president Morsi on his lack of interest in the economic crisis of the Arab republic of Egypt;
7. Requests expanding of farms in Egypt especially in the following areas:
 - a. El Fayoum,
 - b. Luxor,
 - c. Aswan,
 - d. El Daqahlia,
 - e. Al Ismailia;
8. Demands the increase of water pumps in the Al Wadi Al Gedid area because of the diffusion of underground water lakes;
9. Calls upon adding more attention in the driving lessons and becoming more strict in the driving tests in order to insure traffic security and stability;
10. Proclaims grouping every driver in Egypt in a sequence of time and letting them retake their driving tests;
11. Demands increasing the number of police forces in the streets to insure the safety of the Egyptian citizen;
12. Calls upon building electricity producing factories in Egypt;
13. Requests making more underground phone lines (for faster internet) to all Egyptian;
14. Proclaims making strict laws restricting smuggling of gas, or any other type of resources;
15. Recommends adding more buses so less bus population jams are caused;
16. Further recommends raising awareness of using electricity and water too much;

17. Consider using energy efficient appliances to save more electricity and power;
18. Further recommends raising awareness on water pollution;
19. Requests to sue all the factories that throw away their remnants in the Nile;
20. Requests the teaching of teenagers on the respect of environment;
21. Recommends the constructor of a second level of the bridges 6th of October and 15th of May;
22. Considering the use of a double deck public transportation busses and studying the proper routes that are obstacle free concerning the height of the double deck bus to start with;
23. Further recommends that all stop lights to be accessorized with cameras to inform the law;
24. Reminds that in case of parking in an no parking area the vehicle is to be confiscated temporally of 10 days and a bale to be charged agency it's driver;
25. Calls upon the construction of underground parking areas;
26. Demands that each property that is built should reserve and have a parking area of its own;
27. Requests the increase of the transportation comfortableness and cleanliness;
28. Approves the use of low coast solar water heaters by utilizing the sun which is the most available source of energy in Egypt;
29. Recommends the building of solar panels in the dry areas along highway roads such as:
 - a. Alexandria road
 - b. Ein El Sokhna road

- c. Sharm El Sheikh road
- d. Ismailia road
- e. Urghada road

30. Encourages the improvements of streets and sidewalks by paving them correctly;
31. Further resolves the enlarging of the roads so it can have enough capacity of traffic;
32. Further invites to repave the old roads converting to freeways by smart crossings of bridges or tunnels.
33. Requests the removal for 24 hours of any Microbus that disrupts the traffic order, and that parks in the middle of the road;
34. Further recommends that transportation services only occur at night (between 11PM and 7AM) so it doesn't cause more traffic jams.
